## ICD-10 Resource Center

The Centers for Medicare & Medicare Services (CMS) announced the new deadline for ICD-10 implementation will be Oct. 1, 2015. The delay to the Oct. 1, 2014 date was included in the Protecting Access to Medicare Act of 2014, which stated that ICD-10 could not be adopted prior to Oct. 1, 2015. The government expects to issue an interim final rule in the near future that will officially include the new 2015 compliance date and require physician practices and other HIPAA-covered entities to continue to use ICD-9-CM through Sept. 30, 2015.
